



Statement of Christian Conduct

Camp Cedarbrook in the Adirondacks is committed to reaching young girls for Christ. We live in a close-knit, strong Christian community with one another. Being a Cedarbrook staff member, *volunteer, and/or board member*, I attest that I have experienced salvation through faith in Jesus Christ, and am living an exemplary Christian life before both campers and staff.

In addition to being in agreement with Camp Cedarbrook's spiritual standards, statement of faith, and doctrinal positions, I understand that I am joining a community that is called to serve and lead as Christ.

Although I recognize that I live in a fallen world and that sin is part of our humanity (including myself), I intend to show others, through the grace of Christ and the Holy Spirit, a life that mirrors Christ. I acknowledge that I am to present myself as a living and holy sacrifice acceptable to God (Romans 12:1-2), to live a life above reproach (1 Timothy 3:2), and to do my best to refrain from behavior that might cause another person to stumble or be confused (1 Corinthians 8:9).

As a representative of Camp Cedarbrook and while serving at the Camp, I will comply in my daily behavior with the following:

- I will abstain from the use of alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs or drugs other than those legally prescribed to me during the period of my summer staff agreement (Ephesians 5:18; 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Galatians 6:8).
- I will abstain from sexual intercourse and other forms of sexual behavior until marriage (Genesis 2:24; Hebrews 13:4; 1 Corinthians 7; Ephesians 5:3).
- I will abstain from cursing or unwholesome talk during the period of my summer staff agreement (James 1:26; Ephesians 4:29).

I acknowledge that our responsibility as leaders means that even outside the term of the summer staff agreement and period of working at the Camp, I will continue to live a life that is pleasing to Christ. I commit to hold myself and other staff members accountable to these above standards and the standards that Christ has set out for us in His holy word, the Bible (2 Timothy 3:16; Romans 12:2).
